Surgeons specializing in arthroscopy may elect to participate in the official course of the Argentine Association of Arthroscopy. The course runs from March to December annually.

Arthroscopic fellows who are in their 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of an orthopaedic and traumatology residence program are eligible. Fellows usually come from:

- University hospitals
- National and regional hospitals from Argentina, as well as other South American countries like Uruguay, Brazil, Chile, Paraguay, Bolivia and Peru.



The center runs theoretical classes, as well as practical instructional courses and workshops that address specific subjects such as the knee, shoulder, ankle and other joints. Fellows can expect to work in a variety of departments, including ambulatory, surgery, imaging, dissections and athenaeums.

The center performs about 600 arthroscopic surgeries per year, of which 70% are knee, 17% are shoulder, 8% are ankle, 2% are elbow, 2% are wrist, and 1% are hip. Surgical days are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm.
