TYPES OF COURSES

The Orthopaedic Research Foundation of Southern Illinois offers 3 – 12 month fellowship programs where international physicians have the opportunity to observe surgical techniques, clinical procedures and examinations; attend educational meetings nationwide; and participate in research programs at our facility.

The research projects are assigned according to the physician's area of interest. They consist of literature research, clinical data abstraction and cadaver dissection. The results of their research projects are then submitted for publication and presentation.

Southern Illinois University School of Medicine provides the affiliation for the J-1 visas. St. Mary's-Good Samaritan Hospital assists with housing and meals for the fellows.



For the fellowship programs, The Orthopaedic Research Foundation of Southern Illinois utilizes the facility of the Orthopaedic Center of Southern Illinois.

Under the direction of James Chow, MD, the fellows have the opportunity to observe a variety of surgical and clinical observations of the five group physicians, and perform cadaver studies in the surgical suite. In addition, the fellows may
